Confirmation delays can be avoided if visitors when sending email request **Please do not ask questions in your emails!** Please do not ask the staff to be your friend on Facebook, and do not ask the staff for any special requests. (yes, visitors are doing this!)

**New changes(1)** Visitors are required to write the number of pages of documents they are bringing in with them on the visit at the top of their visiting pass. Please request staff to initial during processing.

**(2)** Two factory sealed single serving size of infant powdered formula is now allowed.

**(3)** Two keys-one may be an electronic car key is now allowed.

**(4)** Allowed photos now include size 8x10

## VENDORS

Please remember to not form lines when the vendors are restocking and if you have questions or concerns for them, please wait until after they have finished restocking.

## Games

## Restrooms

Has a new porter in place to clean the bathrooms during visiting to keep the bathrooms clean. Let Bubble Officer know if supplies are low or cleaning is needed in the restrooms.

## MEDICAL INFORMATION

It is extremely important that inmates fill out a medical release form that allows the prison to communicate with a loved one if there is a medical issue. Without that form, the medical staff cannot give out any information. Inmates can get the forms at the clinic. All calls at CSP-Solano regarding health care have to go through the ROI Access line 707-454-3497 calls should be returned with-in 2 business days.
