
VISITING INFORMATION

Clothing Information: Just as a reminder to our families as of March 31, 2010 hats, gloves and scarves are no longer allowed in visiting. (Except in inclement weather). Also, look for the new clothing posters in the processing areas.

VENDORS

The vendor would like to announce the arrival of the new vending machines! We now have more selection as our vendor has added soups, tuna packs, cereal and more. Please remember to not form lines when the vendors are restocking and if you have questions or concerns for them, please wait until after they have finished restocking. The vendor also would like for our visitors to please be mindful and respectful of the supplies such as plates, napkins, eating utensils, and condiments. Avoid waste so that we can have a plentiful supply for all families. Please avoid using supplies to save your tables. Your cooperation would be greatly appreciated.

Games

IFC and other visitors have donated a lot of new games. We ask you to please take care of them, try to return them to the VR porters with all the original pieces you started with!

Terminations- Due to overcrowding, terminations will occur. Please purchase your food early in your visit as you will be expected to leave as soon as you are terminated. There is no longer a 15 minute window after termination.

Restrooms

In an effort to keep the restrooms stocked and clean we request that visitors report to the Bubble officer when supplies run low and cleaning is needed. Please take pride in the restroom and do your part to keep clean for others by not allowing paper products etc. to land on the floor.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

It is extremely important that inmates fill out a medical release form that allows the prison to communicate with a loved one if there is a medical issue. Without that form, the medical staff cannot give out any information.

All calls at CSP-Solano regarding health care have to go through the ROI Access line 707-454-3497 calls should be returned with-in 2 business days.

New to the Prison System?

If you are new to the prison system, please see any Inmate Family Council member or Lt. Tyler and we will provide a booklet for you that can help you navigate through the system. It includes information on how to send packages, money, mail regulations, dress codes and much more.
