WARDEN'S NEWS

Visiting hours are 8:00am-2:30 PM.

The Warden continues to monitor the effect of the new visiting hours. Staff is coming in earlier for more training and to be sure there is a full complement of officers for a successful visiting program.

The administration monitors the modified programs daily. It is their intention to have all inmates on normal program as soon as possible.

Inmates will be getting more fresh vegetables in their lunches. Onion, peppers and other seasonal fare will be included in the inmate diet.

HALLOWEEN FUN AT SOLANO

Children 8 years old and under may wear costumes on Oct. 31st. Masks and face paint are not allowed and all costumes must clear the metal detector.

The Inmate Family Council will be passing out treats to all in the visiting room on that day.

INCLEMENT WEATHER CLOTHING

Starting Oct. 31, hats, gloves and scarves may be worn to visiting. Hats must be removed in the visiting rooms. A light jacket, sweatshirt or sweater may be worn in addition to a coat. All outerwear must be removed for search before entering the visiting room.

APPOINTMENT TIMES

Visitors may not arrive more than 10 minutes late for their visiting appointment. Late arrivals back up the system and cause those who are on time to be delayed.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

It is extremely important that inmates fill out a medical release form that allows the prison to communicate with a loved one if there is a medical issue. Without the form, per strict HIPPA regulations, the medical staff cannot give out any information. Inmates can get the forms at the clinic. All calls at CSP Solano regarding health care have to go through the ROI Access line (707) 454-3497. Calls should be returned within 2 business days.

DONATION FORMS

When donating anything to the visiting rooms, a donation form must be filled out and accompany the item(s). Donation forms can be downloaded from the IFC website, www.ifc-solano.org. Look on the right hand side of the homepage and click on Donations.

ELECTRONIC KEYS/DEVICES

Please remember that only one electronic key device may go into the visiting room. Visitors may have two keys on a plain ring or a visitor may have one key and one electronic key device on a plain ring. No other attachments are allowed.

Inmate Locator Number/Identification Unit

You can locate an inmate within the jurisdiction of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation by telephone or online. To locate an inmate by telephone, call the Identification Unit at (916) 445-6713. You must provide the full name and the month, day and year of birth of the inmate or their CDCR identification number for your inquiry. This unit can only provide you with the current location and CDCR identification number for the offender. The Identification Unit does not have, and will not provide, any future release date information. This service is available only Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. excluding state holidays. To locate an inmate online please visit the following website: <http://inmatelocator.cdcr.ca.gov/>. You need to provide either the inmate's full name, or identification number Please note that information for offenders recently admitted into or transferred between state prisons may not be available for up to seven (7) business days

We send that out to our subscribed email list. It is not a chat room but rather just used to keep you up-to-date with changes as they occur.
